

This digitally printed Art Nouveau panel of Alphonse Mucha's "Garden Goddess" from Robert Kaufman takes us back into the late 1800's when Mucha was known for his magazine illustrations and theater posters of such notables as Sarah Bernhardt.





Northcott is also showing bright colors and modern vibes with their Zoometrix fabrics.
